SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Luke 7:1-10 is the story of Jesus healing the centurion's servant. What stands out to you the most about this centurion?
2. What stands out to you the most about Jesus in this story with the centurion and his sick servant?
3. Luke 7:11-17 is the story of Jesus raising the widow's son. Here Jesus is not even asked to do this miracle and yet Jesus raises him from the dead anyway. Why do you think Jesus did this?
4. What else stands out to you about this story of Jesus raising this widow's son?
5. Which attribute of Jesus do you struggle to see more in Jesus: His compassion or His power? Why is that?
6. How can we go about growing in our understanding of Jesus' compassion and power?
7. How would your relationship with Jesus change if you saw more of His compassion? And how would that change your day-to-day way of life?
8. How would your relationship with Jesus change if you saw more of His power? And how would that change your day-to-day way of life?
